CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

I started my career in obstetrics and gynaecology in Liverpool where I trained as an undergraduate. As senior house officer to Mr Robert Atlay, at Mill Road Maternity Hospital, I learnt my basic skills; before moving to London in 1976 to take up a research post with Mr Stuart Stanton at St. George's Hospital. During a very fruitful two years I investigated and treated over six hundred women with lower urinary tract disorders using urodynamic techniques, and was responsible for the day to day running of the Urodynamic Unit.

As a registrar at King's College and Dulwich Hospitals, in addition to all the routine duties, I spent a session each week in the Menopause and Infertility clinics and set up my own Urodynamic clinic which I have continued to run ever since. I also took an interest in the management of normal and abnormal labour. The two years I spent as senior registrar to Sir Rustam Feroze, then President of the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists, were extremely interesting. I learnt various operative techniques for cancer of the female genital tract and saw many uncommon and complicated cases. During this time I ran the colposcopy clinic. The last part of my training was spent in district general hospitals, at Greenwich and Lewisham where I enjoyed the busy work-load. I learnt the rudiments of ultrasonography and was able to continue to see and treat women with lower urinary tract dysfunction one day each week at King's.

CONSULTANT PRACTICE

I took up my nine session consultant post at King's College and Dulwich hospitals in 1985. In 1990 Women's Health Services centralised on the King's site, and since the end of 1993 my "job plan" has changed so that I now concentrate on Urogynaecology and general gynaecology. My weekly timetable includes three operating lists, gynaecology and urogynaecology outpatients, urodynamics clinics and teaching ward rounds. In addition my team of urogynaecology registrars, research fellows and nurses carry out a further four urodynamics clinics, day case operating list, and a specialist urogynaecology clinic under my aegis. I am "on call" for acute gynaecology and emergency admissions 1:6. In 2002 we appointed a second consultant urogynaecologist, Mr John Bidmead who was trained by me at King's College Hospital.

In 1994 the title of Professor of Urogynaecology was conferred on me but this has not significantly changed my working commitments.

REGULAR MEETINGS

Departmental meetings are held at King's throughout the year and I regularly attend the Women's Health Care Group, gynaecological pathology meetings, and gynaecology audit meetings.

UROGYNAECOLOGY

Since I started work as a registrar at King's in 1979 patients with lower urinary tract disorders have been referred to me by local gynaecologists and urologists and I established urodynamics at King's. I now see many complicated tertiary referrals, some of the patients from outside the area are sent back to their referring consultants for treatment but I frequently perform the incontinence surgery on women whose previous operations have failed. I have a year 4/5 specialist registrar under my aegis who may learn urodynamics and whom I teach incontinence surgery. In addition there are frequent visitors to the Urodynamic Unit and quite often consultants with an interest come to King's to operate with me. In 1996 we received recognition from the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists to become a subspecialty training centre for Urogynaecology. Mr Vik Khullar completed his training in February 2000, and Mr John Bidmead in February 2002. Mr Dudley Robinson, currently in post, is the third subspecialty trainee.

Despite the high prevalence of urinary incontinence amongst the female population, and its devastating effect on the quality of life of those who suffer, until 1992 no financial provision was made within the Camberwell Health Authority budget, apart from the salary of one Continence Advisor. Therefore, I raised the money to pay for the service including the salaries, purchase of new equipment and repairs to the existing urodynamic equipment, much of which was home-made and very old. However, in 1992 with the changes in the National Health Service we were given the contract for female urodynamics by the South East London Commissioning Authority (South East London Health Authority) which partially paid for the service. We are able to perform all the modern urodynamic investigations, and have expanded our ambulatory urodynamic facilities; although we are dependent upon the department of radiology for imaging facilities.

In 1983 I was awarded a Birthright grant which paid my first research fellow's salary. Since then there have been at least four female urodynamic sessions each week enabling six to eight women to be investigated at each clinic. In 1999, over 1,500 patients were investigated in the Urodynamic Unit. I have trained all the research fellows myself; they have been responsible for investigating and treating incontinent women who are referred to me and often monitor treatment and follow-up. Currently in addition to the sub-specialty trainee there are two Research Registrars, a Urogynaecology Sister and research nurse, two healthcare assistants and a full time physiotherapist in post.

In 1992 we established our Urodynamic Clinic for the Assessment and Aeviuw of the Elderly (U-CARE) specifically organised to assess and investigate frail elderly and disabled patients for whom standard videocystourethrography might be difficult. This is a nurse led clinic which facilitates continuity of care between the hospital and community.

TEACHING

I enjoy teaching at all levels, but particularly postgraduates, either individually or in groups. I give tutorials and lectures to each group of medical students as well as teaching them on ward rounds, in clinics and whilst operating. From 1993-1996 I was coordinator of Undergraduate teaching in Obstetrics and Gynaecology appointed by the Medical School.

On eight consecutive occasions until 1986 I helped to organise the King's MRCOG course which was then an intensive twice yearly course involving more than a hundred hours of

tuition covering all aspects of the part II examination, including viva technique, the use of English, as well as factual modern obstetrics and gynaecology. Since then I have helped our own registrars with their MRCOG part II. In 1995 we ran our own Practical Urodynamics course, which proved to be most successful and we now run joint courses in conjunction with Birmingham and Southampton.

I have taught urodynamics and incontinence surgery to a succession of registrars in obstetrics and gynaecology at King's, as well as many outsiders. All my junior staff learn gynaecological surgery at an appropriate level under my direct supervision. On the wards, I listen to the medical students case histories but direct my teaching towards the junior doctors as well. I encourage active debate and hope that this stimulates interest.

My colleagues in other hospitals frequently invite me or my research fellows to speak at meetings, and teach at their courses on all aspects of lower urinary tract dysfunction.

EXAMINING

As a registrar, senior registrar and now as a consultant, I have been involved in the continual assessment and end of firm examination of medical students and have examined in the Senior Scholarship examinations. I am a senior examiner in obstetrics and gynaecology for the London MB BS examinations and was the chairman of the Part VIII examinations (1996-1998).

Together with Mr Stuart Stanton I prepared a "Careers Guide" for aspiring gynaecologists and obstetricians which I revised in 1988 for the second edition. In 1989 I organised the production of a careers video, to aid recruitment into the specialty. In 1985 I gave the College Christmas lecture for young people which was attended by over 400 in the morning and 250 in the afternoon. I was on the Organising Committee for the 25th British Congress of Obstetrics and Gynaecology which was held in London in July 1989, and was considered to be both scientifically and socially successful. In 1995 I organised the RCOG Practical Urodynamics Course which was highly rated and attended by 230 delegates. In 2001 I co-chaired and organised the 42nd Study Group on Incontinence and subsequent College meeting which was completely sold out and not successful. In 2004 I have been invited to participate in the Study Group on the Menopause and Hormone Replacement Therapy

RESEARCH

I have been actively involved in clinical research since 1976. In 1979 I was awarded an MD for my thesis entitled "The investigation and treatment of detrusor instability in women". Although most of my work has been related to lower urinary tract dysfunction, I have also published on labour and the menopause. Research is very important to me and enables me to enjoy an interesting and varied career. Because of my other commitments, nowadays, most of the actual work is organised and carried out by my research fellows but I am actively involved, many of the ideas are mine and I generate the funding. To date 10 MD theses

have been awarded to the Urogynaecology Research Fellows at King's.

The current research fellows spend half their time carrying out clinical health service work as registrars in Urodynamics/Urogynaecology and the remainder doing research. We work closely with the District Continence Advisory Service who undertake clinical assessment of incontinence aids including pads, pants and catheters.
