### **SUMMATIVE**

I was born and educated in India. I obtained my medical qualifications from the Madras Medical College, University of Madras in 1989.

I was then trained in General Surgery in the Republic of Ireland and United Kingdom respectively.

I was awarded the Fellow of the Royal Colleges of Physicians and Surgeons, Glasgow in 1993. After completion of Higher Surgical Training as a Calman Registrar in North London I was appointed to King's College Hospital, London as a Senior Clinical Fellow in Liver Transplantation and Hepato-Pancreato-Biliary Surgery in 1997.

I was awarded the Inter-Collegiate Fellowship (FRCS-Gen Surg) with sub speciality interest in Transplantation by the Royal College of Surgeons in 2003 after successfully passing the Inter-Collegiate exit examination held by the Royal Colleges of the United Kingdom and was entered into the list of Specialist Surgeons held by the General Medical Council of the United Kingdom.
