Dr Plowman has a long term interest in advances in the radiotherapeutic methods to treat prostate cancer – both external beam conformal and seed brachytherapy – and hormonal methods of therapy .

He has been Head of Department from 1989-1997 and from 2000 to the present time.

He has published around 300 research papers in radiotherapy and clinical oncology.
