CLINICAL RESPONSIBILITIES

My specialist interests include the management of breast cancer, head and neck cancer, skin tumours and AIDS related malignancies.

I am Co-Chairman of the Skin Tumour Board of the North London Cancer Network and Member of the Breast, Head and Neck and Upper GI Malignancy Tumour Boards.

My responsibilities at the Middlesex Hospital include the complete care of patients with many types of malignant disease both as in-patients and out-patients. I co-ordinate a multidisciplinary approach to treatment and am particularly interested in the technical aspects of radiotherapy and its correlation with chemotherapy. I have developed the use of whole body electron therapy, both for mycosis fungoides and other skin tumours. Patients are referred from wide areas for this expertise. The joint management, with the HIV team of patients with AIDS related malignancy, led to the appointment and training of the first UK AIDS Oncology SpR.

At the St John's Institute of Dermatology at St Thomas' Hospital, with the other members of the skin tumour unit, a joint clinic of national and international reputation is run for management of patients with rare skin disorders.

I am asked to present views on public medical concerns on the radio and television, especially with reference to my work as medical advisor to several medical charities.

RESEARCH

My thesis was on the application of cell kinetics in radiobiology to radiotherapy practice. When in America I was able to undertake laboratory research using mice to elucidate the relationship between radio-sensitivity and blood sugar.

My special areas of research which arise from my clinical expertise include developing clinical trials of management of breast cancer, skin tumours, head and neck cancers, Kaposi's sarcoma and AIDS related lymphomas using both innovative radiotherapy, chemotherapy and newer hormone regimes. These activities are co-ordinated by my research team.

As Chairman of the Multicentre Cancer Chemotherapy Group I co-ordinated the clinical investigation of patients with breast cancer. Twenty-five centres throughout Great Britain, Northern Ireland and Eire contributed to these studies.

With my research colleague, I am developing the use of radio-isotope labelled methylene blue in the diagnosis and management of malignant melanoma.

Though my interest in mycosis fungoides and Sezary Syndrome, I have surveyed the national need and indications for total skin electron beam therapy, in connection with an international development programme I jointing instigated.

I have a special interest in the management of patients with cholangio-carcinomas, with external beam radiotherapy, chemotherapy and high dose iridium implantation and am initiating Phase II studies.

TEACHING

I am a recognised teacher of the University of London and have been an examiner for the Royal College of Radiologists. For seven years I organised the London Teaching Course of the Royal College of Radiologists.

The combined clinics at the Royal National Throat, Nose and Ear Hospital include teaching of both ENT surgeons and clinical oncologists in this specialised area with an international surgical elite team.

Teaching has been an exciting and important part of my career. I lecture to undergraduates and postgraduates studying for the DMRT, FRCR, MRCP and FRCS examinations. I have given talks, demonstrations and chaired discussion groups for the FRCR course and the courses of the Society of Radiographers. I teach undergraduates weekly as part of my student firm. At St John's Hospital I lecture to and teach students taking the Diploma of Dermatology.

I am considered a successful communicator and receive many invitations to lecture nationally and internationally.

INTERNATIONAL ACTIVITIES

I am particularly interested in training postgraduate doctors in countries with a developing interest in oncological management. These include such countries as Sri Lanka, India, Pakistan, Saudi Arabia, Jordan and Kuwait etc, I have had the opportunity to advise the Governments of Kuwait, Nigeria, Jordan, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Egypt and Saudi Arabia on the development of radiotherapy services. I have helped to devise postgraduate examinations and have examined in some of these countries. I have lectured and taught on many occasions by personal invitation in South America (Uruguay, Argentina and Brazil), in Singapore, Hong Kong, Canada, USA, Australia and Russia as well as in Europe.
