Trained in Orthopaedic Surgery Bristol, UK, rotation from 1997 – 2002 and obtained the Intercollegiate Specialty Examination in Trauma and Orthopaedics in November 2001.

I chose to specialise in Hand Surgery and completed a 2 year international fellowship at centres of excellence around the world. This included 6 months at the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre in Oxford, UK, 6 months at the Royal North Shore Hospital in Sydney, Australia, and 6 months at the 'Institut de la Main' centre for Hand Surgery in Paris, France.

On return to the UK I was awarded the 'Pulvertaft Fellowship' to fund a period of specialist training of my own choice in the UK. I spent this time working with Professor R. Birch at the Peripheral Nerve Injuries Unit, Stanmore, Mr P. Smith in Congenital Hand Surgery at Great Ormond St Hospital, London and with Mr D. Evans specialising in Wrist and Carpal Instability work at The Hand Clinic, Windsor.

I obtained a post as a Consultant Orthopaedic Hand Surgeon for the NHS in June 2004 based at Chelsea and Westminster Hospital, London. I undertake private practice at the Wellington Hospital, London and The Lister Hospital, London.

My practice covers all aspects of Hand and Wrist Surgery including joint replacement, Dupuytren's Disease, peripheral nerve decompression, carpal instability, rheumatoid arthritis, and trauma including scaphoid and distal radius fractures.
