King's College Hospital, London is a prestigious international teaching hospital with a long history of clinical excellence. Since our foundation in 1840 we have been associated with the advancement of medical science and patient care across a wide range of disciplines.

The first operation performed under antiseptic conditions, took place here in 1877, laying the foundations for future advances in surgery. The Florence Nightingale School of Nursing & Midwifery was the world's first professional school of nursing and was established at King's by Florence Nightingale in 1860.

Our pioneering approach means that we are the only UK centre approved for gene therapy and lead the field in breakthrough techniques such as keyhole surgery for aortic valve replacement. Our technique of non related bone marrow transplants for leukaemia patients aged over 50 is now an established and widely accepted procedure.

Housed in a beautiful Art Deco building, the Guthrie Wing is dedicated to private patients and delivers the highest possible standards of care.

Our state of the art equipment and laboratory facilities form just part of the story. You will receive specialist consultant expertise tailored to your needs, plus the services of our clinical director, alongside skilled nursing and pharmacy teams. They are all committed fully to ensuring your safety and care, underpinned by our 'King's behaviour standards' programme.

King's College Hospital forms part of the NHS (National Health Service) which ensures that we have our finger on the pulse when it comes to clinical best practices and standards. What's more, to benefit all of our patients – NHS and private alike – we ensure the income generated by our private patient services is used to further develop our world class facilities and leading edge clinical services.

Medical expertise

State of the art treatment and medical care

Our state of the art diagnostic and therapeutic facilities mean we can offer private patients the most advanced medical treatments available in the world today.

We are internationally recognised for our clinical expertise in the treatment of adults and children in liver disease, neurosciences, cancer and cardiac disease, together with a range of over 100 other clinical specialities.

Liver medicine and liver surgery

Operating the largest paediatric liver transplant programme in Europe and the biggest adult liver transplant programme in the UK, we achieve more first class patient outcomes than any other centre. Our liver service incorporates a dedicated transplant theatre and 14 bed intensive care unit, while our clinical expertise extends to ground breaking treatments for liver cancers and diseases.

Haematology

A specialist centre for adult Bone Marrow Transplantation (BMT), we have over 80 physicians and scientists supporting ground breaking treatments, such as gene therapy and are the only approved UK centre in this field. We also specialise in white cell disorders such as leukaemia and aplastic anaemia.

Adult and paediatric neurosciences

We are the UK's largest neurosurgical unit and the only hospital in London to offer every neurosurgical sub speciality for both adults and children.

Our neuro-oncology service is closely linked to the oncology service at London's world leading Royal Marsden Hospital and in close collaboration with Guy's and St Thomas' Hospitals we offer the only comprehensive adult and paediatric deep brain stimulation service in London – a recognised treatment for tremor, Parkinson's disease and dystonia.

Obstetrics

King's offers a consultant led obstetric service. We have one of the highest figures for consultant cover on our labour wards and also maintain a caesarean section rate which is below the national average and one of the best in London.

Cardiac services

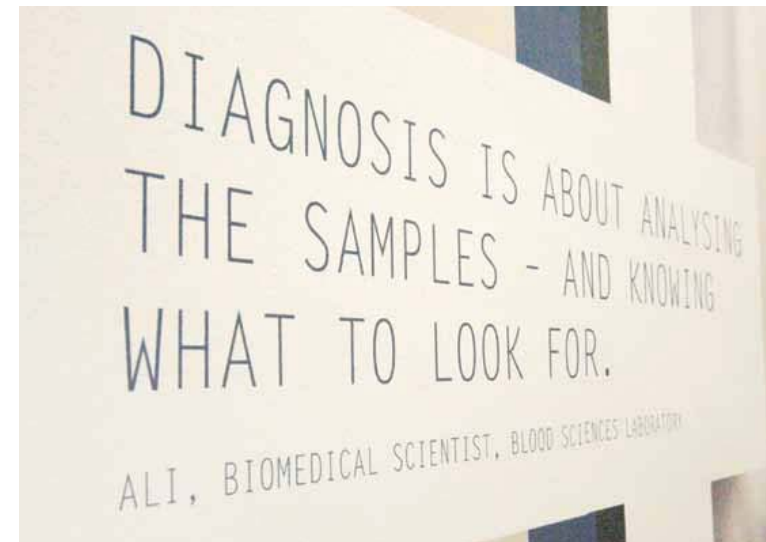
King's cardiac unit is now performing more open heart surgery and interventional cardiology than ever before. Our comprehensive services are award winning and we are renowned for our ground breaking clinical and academic work.

With a multi disciplinary approach to cardiovascular and thoracic disease guaranteed by on site cardiothoracic surgeons, vascular surgeons, cardiologists and respiratory physicians, King's College Hospital has a distinguished history of advancements in the treatment of cardiovascular diseases in adults. We are an internationally leading centre for minimally invasive heart valve treatment, including transcatheter heart valve implantation, and offer new ground breaking therapies to treat coronary artery disease and disease of the thoracic and thoraco-abdominal aorta.

Carrying out cutting edge procedures and operations on a daily basis means that we are recognised as leaders in cardiac care.

Exceptional facilities, life changing care

King's International offers excellence in both clinical and nursing care.

Our first rate amenities include state of the art theatres, a private outpatient suite with five consulting rooms, reception area, day surgery facilities, a two bed dependency unit, as well as a day room and ward. We offer 21 pleasantly furnished en suite single rooms, complete with a nurse call system for private patient stays.

Our world renowned Neurosurgical Unit uses leading edge technology including two image guidance systems and three stereotactic frames for high precision surgery, while our Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory provides powerful diagnostic services.



We also employ the newest medical imaging technologies to assist with early diagnosis of heart disease and the detection of cancer, to include Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI), Computerised Axial Tomography (CT) and Positron Emission Tomography (PET) scanners.

The King's Craniofacial Prosthetic Unit recreates life like ears, eyes and even noses for patients who have lost them in accidents or as a result of an illness. This highly specialised service is recognised as one of the best in the world with patients travelling from around the globe for the incredibly realistic results.

Interpretation and translation services

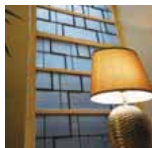

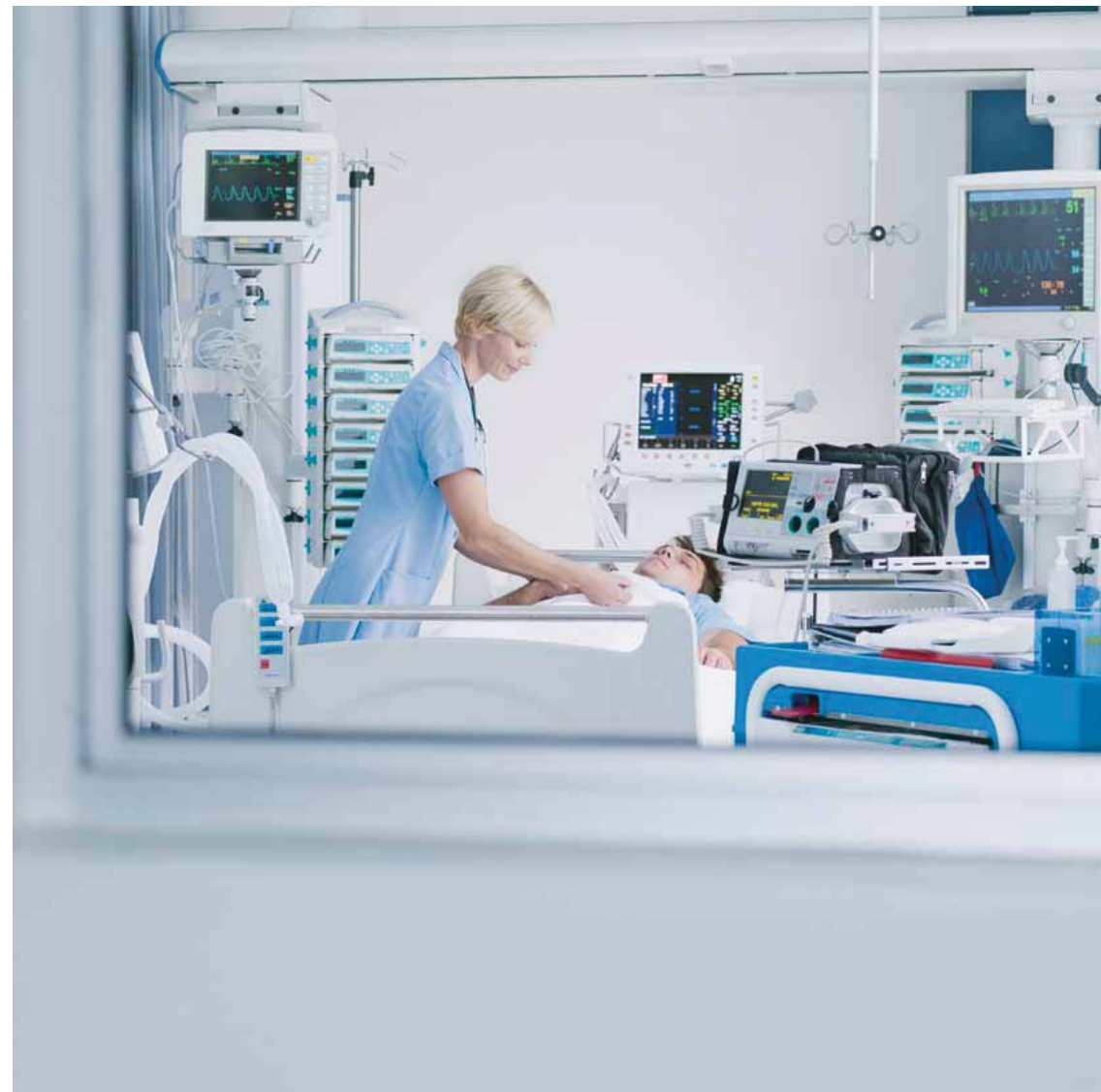

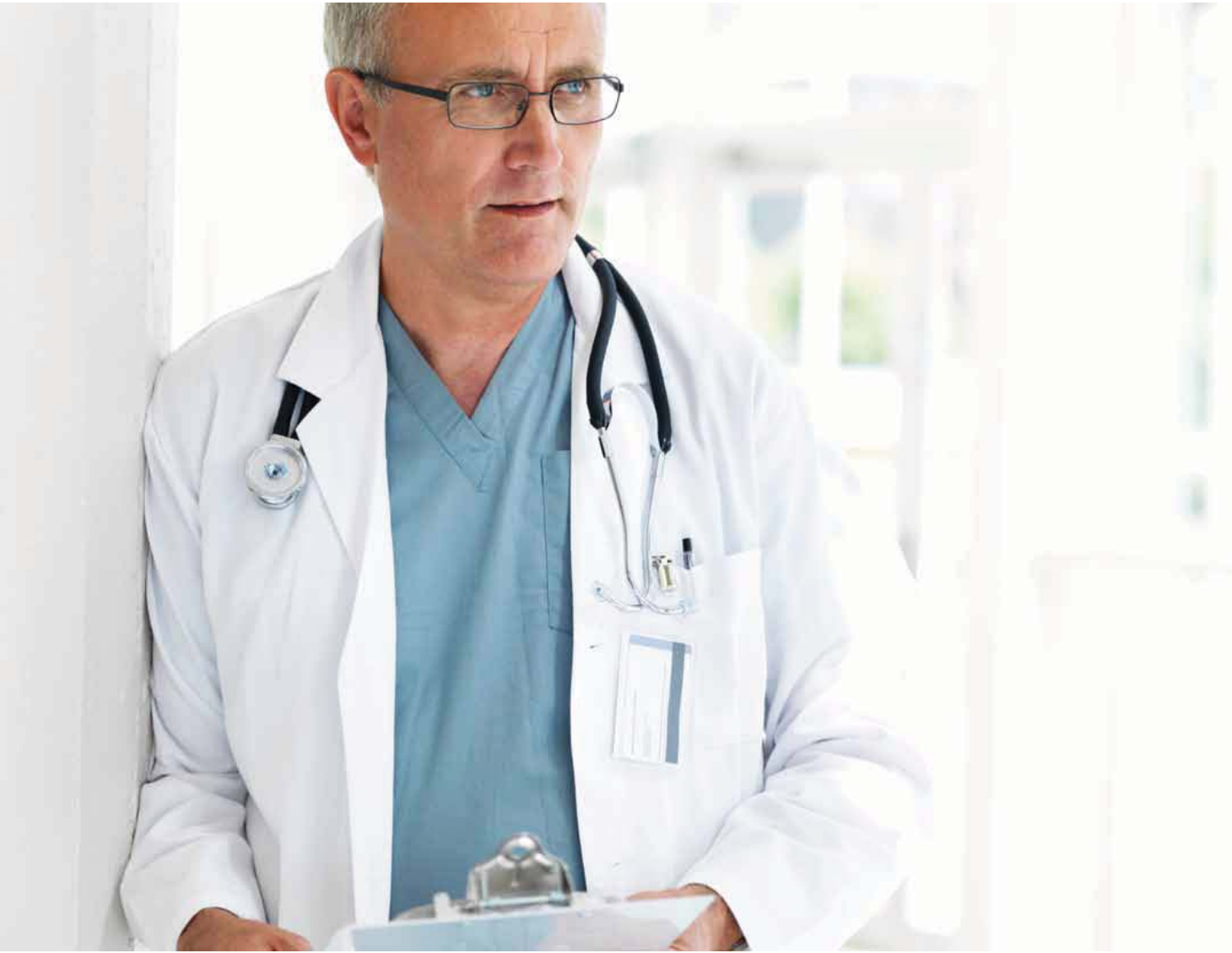
International insurance

Getting to King's by train

Denmark Hill station

King's is about 5 minutes walk from Denmark Hill.
The station is served by regular direct rail links to Central London at Kings Cross St Pancreas (22 minutes), London Bridge (12 minutes) and Victoria (9 minutes), as well as to principal places in South East London such as Bromley South, Catford, Lewisham and Peckham Rye.

Loughborough Junction station

King's is about 12 minutes walk from Loughborough Junction. Bus routes 35, 45 and 345 run from the station to the hospital.

Both stations are in Travelcard Zone 2. Please also note that that there are about 30 steps to access the platforms at both stations and there is no wheelchair access.

Getting to King's by bus

Bus routes that stop at King's: 35, 40, 42, 45, 68, 176 (24 hour), 185, 345 (24 hour), 468, 484, N35, N68.
All the stops are in travelcard zone 2.
